Competition Checklist

Please note that entries that do not conform to the specifications for the image file or abstract will be rejected.

Submission

Only one submission per student, or staff member can be entered into the competition, your submission must be accompanied by an abstract. You must own the copyright for the image used, and have gained permissions from any identifiable persons (or their legal guardians) contained within the image.

Images

Images submitted for consideration in the competition:

- Should be full colour or black and white
- Should not contain added text
- Can be submitted in portrait or landscape orientation. Final exhibition/display of your image will vary depending on orientation
- Should be the highest resolution possible, due to printing at A1 size
- Either jpg, png or tif format (no gif files accepted).
- Should not be a poster, we need just one image.

Abstract

Each submission must include an abstract describing the image and how it relates, or is a reflection of your research. As the abstract will be read by members of the general public and other non-specialists, you must ensure that the abstract uses plain English and is jargon-free. Maximum abstract length is strictly **150 words.**

Subject Limitations

No explicit/graphic content or portrayals of illegal activities. Submissions that, in the sole discretion of the judges, are considered inappropriate or unsuitable for publication will be deemed ineligible and removed from the competition.
