## Submission Guidelines

All postgraduate research students are eligible to submit a presentation, poster or Three Minute Thesis abstract. All entrants must be currently registered for a research degree at the University of Lincoln on the date of the Showcase.

#### Showcase Presentation

The presentations should be 10 minutes long, and there will be 5 minutes allocated for questions after each presentation.

#### Three Minute Thesis

Three Minute Thesis (3MT<sup>™</sup>) is a research communication competition developed by The University of Queensland which challenges research higher degree students to present a compelling oration on their thesis and its significance in just three minutes in language appropriate to a nonspecialist audience.
